

2025 UCI Gran Fondo World Championships & Time Trial

The annual Amy's Great Ocean Road Gran Fondo, held in memory of Australian cyclist Amy Gillett, will host the 2025 UCI Gran Fondo World Championships. The expanded program of racing will see road closures with the Great Ocean Road transformed into a competitive arena for cyclists from around the globe, chasing the title of becoming a World Champion.

TRAFFIC & TRANSPORT INFO & VEHICLE ESCORTS

In addition to the annual Sunday program, a NEW one-off event is scheduled for THURSDAY, 16 OCTOBER. Over 650 riders will race in a 23km Individual Time Trial on the Great Ocean Road between Lorne and Eastern View.

The Great Ocean Road will be closed as follows:

- 5.00 am - 9.00 am - between Stirling Street and Deans Marsh-Lorne Road Roundabout (for Start / Finish set up - Detour via Dorman St.)
- 9.00 am - 4.30 pm - between the Memorial Arch, Eastern View and Deans Marsh-Lorne Rd Roundabout (both directions for Time Trial)
 - Victoria Police will escort local residents and business vehicles between Lorne and Eastern View at
 - 11.15 am from Lorne *
 - 11.35 am from Eastern View *
 - 1.35 pm from Lorne *
 - 1.55 om from Eastern View *

 - If an escort is required, please be ready ahead of time, as the window to be escorted is small.
- 4.30 pm - 6.00 pm - between Stirling Street and Deans Marsh-Lorne Road Roundabout (for Start / Finish pack down - Detour via Dorman St).

LOCAL ACCESS / APPROVED MOVEMENTS ON TIME TRIAL COURSE

To ensure the safety of all participants and the community, temporary changes to traffic conditions must be implemented. These measures are approved by Victoria Police, Regional Roads Victoria and relevant council authority and will be temporarily installed at all intersections and access points to private property that provide vehicle access to the course.

DIVERSION ROUTE & KEY ACCESS POINTS

Aireys Inlet, Moggs Creek, Fairhaven, Eastern View

- Residents will be able to access the Great Ocean Road from Anglesea at a soft road closure point (local access only).
- Those coming from Lorne direction will be held at Stirling Street & Great Ocean Road, until safely able to be escorted through during a routine traffic flush.*

Lorne

- Local residents coming from Anglesea direction will be held prior to reaching the Great Ocean Road Memorial Arch, until safely able to be escorted through during a routine traffic flush*
- Residents are advised to use the detour option at Forest Road (from Anglesea) instead, and access Lorne via Deans Marsh-Lorne Road.


Anglesea

- Local residents coming from Lorne direction will divert via Stirling Street, and be held at the Great Ocean Road, until safely able to be escorted through during a routine traffic flush*
- Residents are advised to use the detour option at Deans Marsh-Lorne Road instead, and access Anglesea via Forest Road.

Victoria Police will escort local residents and business vehicles between Lorne and Eastern View at

- 11.15 am from Lorne *
- 11.35 am from Eastern View *
- 1.35 pm from Lorne *
- 1.55 pm from Eastern View *
